OpTek Systems products do not fall within the scope of the Directive and therefore OpTek Systems is not required to comply with the provisions of RoHS 3. OpTek Systems can confirm that its products:

- 1. Do not contain any of the 10 restricted hazardous substances: Cadmium, Lead, Mercury, Hexavalent Chromium, Polybrominated Biphenyls, Polybrominated Diphenyl Ethers, Bis(2-Ethylhexyl) phthalate (DEHP), Benzyl butyl phthalate (BBP), Dibutyl phthalate (DBP), Diisobutyl phthalate (DIBP) as listed under Annex II of the Directive.
- 2. Do not contain any electrical or electronic component and therefore does not require an EU declaration of Conformity or affixing the CE mark to our products. OpTek Systems will continue to monitor any new amendments/changes to the Directive and subsequently review its position with regards to compliance. OpTek Systems will also ensure that any new information is communicated to its customers, suppliers and stakeholders as required
