

ROHS (3) COMPLIANCE STATEMENT 2025

OpTek Systems is fully aware of the requirements under the Restriction of Hazardous Substances (RoHS) Directive EU 2015/863 (RoHS 3), which expands upon Directive 2011/65/EU (RoHS 2) by adding four additional restricted substances.

OpTek Systems' products do not fall within the scope of the RoHS Directive; therefore, compliance with RoHS 3 is not legally required. However, OpTek Systems can confirm that its products:

- 1. Do not contain any of the 10 restricted hazardous substances as listed under Annex II of the Directive, including:
 - Heavy metals: Cadmium (Cd), Lead (Pb), Mercury (Hg), and Hexavalent Chromium (Cr⁶⁺)
 - Flame retardants: Polybrominated Biphenyls (PBB) and Polybrominated Diphenyl Ethers (PBDE)
 - Phthalates: Bis(2-Ethylhexyl) phthalate (DEHP), Benzyl butyl phthalate (BBP),
 Dibutyl phthalate (DBP), and Diisobutyl phthalate (DIBP)
- 2. Do not contain any electrical or electronic components and therefore are not subject to EU Declaration of Conformity or the requirement to affix the CE mark.

OpTek Systems remains committed to monitoring any future amendments to the RoHS Directive and will review its compliance position accordingly. Any relevant updates will be communicated to customers, suppliers, and stakeholders as necessary.
